With a striking setting at the confluence of the Sava and Danube rivers, Belgrade is one of the oldest cities in Europe, which has been permanently settled since the mid Neolithic period. In its rich and turbulent history, Belgrade was fought over in 115 wars and rebuilt more than 44 times. From the Celtic dun and the Roman castrum the city grew into a significant border fortification of the Huns and then the Byzantine emperors, the Avars, Bulgars, Ugars, Serbs, Turks and Austrians, until it became the capital of modern Serbia during the 19th century.

Its staggering history, coupled with creativity and laid-back hedonism make today's Belgrade one of southeastern Europe's most interesting cultural destinations. Having diverse architecture, from Baroque and Neoclassicism to Modernism and Brutalism, it has its own distinctive appeal, with storybook historical districts and venerable fortresses and parks.

Belgrade is also home to the finest collection of museums in Serbia. More than 40 museums are open for public, some of them are collection driven such as the Museum of Contemporary Art Belgrade or National Museum, thematic driven as the Yugoslav History Museum or Nikola Tesla Museum, or research oriented as the Museum of Science and Technology.

With population of about 1.7 million people, Belgrade is a dynamic city with vibrant night life scene, thriving cafe culture, rich and varied gastronomy and emerging, design-conscious industrial districts. It is said that hospitality is an innate principle of the Serbian people and it will be our pleasure to ensure you have a good time and enjoyment during your stay.

The best way to get to know Yugoslav history, heritage and culture is by visiting the museum of Yugoslavia, one the most visited museums in Belgrade. Apart from its rich content and authentic exhibitions, the museum is also known as the location of Josip Broz mausoleum.



Skadarlija is considered the main bohemian quarter of Belgrade and often is referred to as 'the Montmartre of Belgrade'. It is located close to the National theatre and it began to assume its bohemian character over the 19th century, when it became the gathering place of the prominent writers, poets and actors. Great care was taken to preserve this unique spirit – the street is still paved in old-Belgrade style cobblestone which used to line all the streets of the city. Many of the taverns from the 19th century are still there, offering traditional music, national specialties and unique atmosphere.

Our suggestions:

- **Temple of St. Sava**, the largest Orthodox church in Balkans, and **Museum of Nikola Tesla** are 10 minutes walking distance from the hotel Hilton.
- **The National Museum** is located at the city center on the main city square called Trg Republike, 20 minutes walking distance from the hotel Hilton and continue to **Kalemegdan**, Belgrade fortress.
- **Museum of contemporary art Belgrade** is located on the confluence of the rivers Sava and Danube in the area called New Belgrade and it is easy to get to by a short taxi ride. If you enjoy walking along the riverside, continue to the area called **Zemun**, a beautiful area located on the right bank of the Danube.



ACCOMMODATION

Arriving from the airport:

If you are taking a taxi from the airport, we recommend you to order from the Taxi info desk located in the arrival area. It is strongly not recommended to use a non-official taxi as their prices can be much higher than official taxi offers. The average price of taxi from airport to city center is 1.400-2.000 RSD, which would be around 12 – 17 EUR.

You can also take the AI Mini shuttle bus (route: Airport - Slavija Square/Kralja Milutina Street - Airport) with approximate travel time of 30 minutes and ticket price of RSD 300 (around 2,5 EUR)

Travel insurance:

As the registration fees do not cover insurance of any kind, you should take out a travel insurance policy which covers medical expenses while you are in Serbia.

Currency and coinage:

The official currency of the country is the Serbian Dinar (RSD). The rate is around 118 Dinars for 1 EUR.

Dinar bills: 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, 500, 1000, 5000

Dress code:

Smart casual for daytime and evening activities.
