INVITATION AND INFORMATION FOR ATTENDING DELEGATES AND ACCOMPANYING PERSONS

Cabinn is situated 2 kilometres from the conference hotel. There will be no transfer from this hotel to the conference hotel. The rooms will be given to those who register first, why we strongly

suggest that you register as soon as possible.

We have made a programme, which will allow you to experience many of the most interesting places not only in Copenhagen, but also outside Copenhagen as further specified in the programme, including:

- a boat trip through the canals of Copenhagen to our office in a military building from 1801, which in itself is an attraction,
- dinner at Admiral Hotel 400 meters from the conference hotel with a sea view,
- interesting guided tours to beautiful royal castles,
- a gala dinner in the magnificent Moltkes Palæ (www.moltkes.com), and, last but not least,
- early morning jogging/running activities Friday and Saturday from the conference hotel.

DELACOUR's offices in Copenhagen are situated in the beautiful, old buildings at Kalvebod Bastion on the Copenhagen waterfront, originally built in 1801 as a depot for the army's vehicles and horses.

The building remained in military use up until the 1950s and was, among other things, used as a mobilisation depot during World War II. The building was since used as a kindergarten and by the Danish Home Guard. In 1988, the exterior of the buildings was renovated, and they were sold to Danisco which undertook the interior refurbishment. Danisco moved out, and since 2008 the buildings have been rented out to DELACOUR. Kalvebod Bastion is a listed building.

TRANSPORT FROM AIRPORT

By Taxi:

There is a taxi stand outside the airport terminal immediately to the right after having passed the customs. The trip from the airport to the conference hotel takes app. 20 minutes and costs app. DKK 250-300 (or less if you use UBER).

By Metro (to conference hotel):

The metro train station is located at the end and top of the arrival hall in Terminal 3, where you shall just walk straight ahead after having passed the customs. Metro tickets can be purchased with credit cards or coins (not notes) in ticket machines at the Metro Station or at the DSB ticket sales counter. The price for a one way ticket to Copenhagen is DKK 36 / app. EUR 5.

All the metro trains go in the same direction from the airport (M2 to Vanløse Station), so you do not have to worry about getting on the wrong train.

The metro runs with 4-6 minutes intervals during the day and evening. During the night the metro runs every 15-20 minutes.

It will take you less than 15 minutes to drive to "Kongens Nytorv" Metro Station, from where there is app. 500 meters, i.e. a walk of app. 7 minutes to the conference hotel.

By Train (to Cabinn City hotel):

The train station is located by terminal 3. The trains run every 10 minutes during the day and will get you to Copenhagen Central Station in about 15 minutes, from where there is approx. 350 meters to Cabinn City. During the night the trains run 1-3 times an hour.

Citypass tickets can be bought at the ticket machines in terminal 3 just above the railway, and at the DSB ticket sales counter, also located in terminal 3. Please note that the machines only accept coins and all major credit cards, not notes.
