

TOUR TO TRAKAI CASTLE & KGB MUSEUM

SUNDAY AT 10 AM.

Duration 4 hours

Trakai - the former capital of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania - is a small town located about 28 km from Vilnius. Situated in a picturesque lakeside area it is one of the most popular tourist attractions of the country. The historical part of the town conserved the ruins of Peninsula Castle, the authentic heritage of small ethnic group Karaites and of course the top must see site – the famous insular Castle on the lake Galve, the original gothic style architectural monument from the end of the XIV century, a historical Museum of Trakai nowadays. Tour includes a visit to Trakai Castle. After the visit you will have some free time to enjoy the beauty of the nature, or have lunch and a short break before going back to Vilnius.

On the way to Trakai you will also visit one of the most interesting and thrilling – KBG museum in the heart of Vilnius. Nowadays Supreme Court used to be premises of Soviet KGB system and had a secret prison in the cellars. Those cells still remind us of the post war and early Soviet period – wait to hear hardly believable stories!
