09:00hrs TOUR TO SACRED VALLEY. Visit to Pisag and Ollantaytambo.

PISAC MARQUET: Pisac, its located 33 km from Cuzco, this the picturesque Andean town, its very famous because of its handicrafts and its Indian Market.

After lunch, you'll visit the Inca fortress of OLLANTAYTAMBO: This Andean toe, is located 21 km from Urubamba. Was called Ollantaytambo in honours of Cacique Ollanta, famous for his romance with KusiQoyllu, daughter of Inca Pacacutec. One of the best conserved areas is in the north and is called HananHuacaypata, formed by 15 blocks of old houses built on stone. The site was built just as the Spaniards arrived and evidence of how it was constructed is still visible. After admiring the site's magnificent past, stroll through the quaint streets of today's town.

Train to AguasCalientes includes welcoming aperitifs, Lunch and an excellent selection of wines, on board music entertainment.

Upon arrival in AguasCalientes, small shuttle buses will be waiting for you to take you to Machu Picchu ruins. You will receive an exclusive Hiram Bingham Passengers Shared Tour of the ruins discovered in 1911 by the explorer Hiram Bingham, this citadel is considered to be one of the most extraordinary examples of landscapes architecture in the world. Located in an enclave on the saddle of a mountain overlooking the deep canyon of the Urubamba River, in an area of lush tropical forest, it served as a place of worship, a site for star-gazing and a private hacienda of the family of the Inca Pachacutec. It consists of two main areas one agricultural, formed mainly by mountains and food stores, and the other urban, which is noted for its sacred zone with its temples, squares and royal tombs. The stairways and canals carved out of stone are recurrent throughout this remarkable archaeological site.

NOVEMBER 12th CUSCO CITY TOUR/LIMA

Breakfast: at the Hotel

Around 09.00am, Guided City Tour visiting the Main Square, known in Inca times as Huacaypata or "The Warriors Square", this was the scene for many key events in Cusco's history. The Cathedral, built between 1560 and 1664 with large stones of red granite taken from the Inca Fortress of Sacsayhuaman, the Cathedral is one of the most imposing structures in the city. It also houses one of the most important collections of gold and silver work of the colonial period, elaborately engraved wooden altars and a beautiful collection of oil on canvas paintings from the EscuelaCusqueña.

Koricancha and the Santo Domingo Convent. The Convent was built on the spectacular Koricancha (site of gold), the most important temple dedicated to the worship of the Sun and whose walls were plated with sheets of gold. As well as, the convent was built above a foundation of smoothened stone structures, the most finely crafted in Cusco, taken from the Inca Sanctuary. Then, we will continue to the nearby ruins: Kenko, where you will see its underground galleries and its semicircular amphitheater. Tambomachay complex of walls connected by stairways, having water springs which fed a well via channels in which apparently the Inca bathed, for it is believed that he also worshipped water. PucaPucara; the red fortress that is located on a hill, possibly to defend Tambomachay and Sacsayhuaman Fortress, an imposing example of Inca military architecture, this fortress was built using large slabs of granite to safeguard the city from Antis attacks or invading forces from the east.

PM: At fixed time transfer to the airport to take your return flight to Lima.
